Wine Orders

WCMC offers premium wines from select regions around the world for your dining pleasure. Have a special wine in mind? WCMC would be pleased to arrange the purchase of this wine on your behalf through LCBO, with advanced notice. A nominal corkage fee of \$9 to cover the associated cost of administration and labour applies.

Reminders...

It is important that the contact information we have on file be kept current and complete should we need to contact you. Please ensure WCMC is notified in writing if there is any change to your address or contact information.

You will be contacted well in advance to arrange your final appointment (which is usually scheduled for 2-6 weeks before your wedding day), along with your assigned rehearsal time (if required). Final catering numbers and payment are not required until 14 days prior to your wedding.

Private Bridal Queuing Area

WCMC is pleased to offer a bridal queuing area for couples getting married onsite. The Garden Room converts into a private waiting room for brides and bridesmaids. It features one-way blinds—allowing you and your bridal party to observe the pre-wedding activities in the privacy of your own room! Note that the 2004 upgrade option of the Bridal Suite for \$195 is no longer available.



Did You Know... SOCAN (Tariff 8)

The Federal Government has instituted a SOCAN fee (Society of Authors, Composers, Musicians, and Music Publishers of Canada), which applies to all events playing music. This charge is required from all banquet halls, in addition to any licensing fees already covered by your DJ or band. It is a federally legislated fee, similar to a tax, which is based on the number of guests and function type. Just a reminder, that this will be reflected in your last statement, once final guests numbers are known and the amount can be calculated. For example, the current SOCAN fee for a dance for over 100 guests is \$59.17. For more information, please refer to their website at www.socan.ca or call 1 800 55 SOCAN.
